

ORDINANCE 1997(8) A

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY, PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF HOPKINS COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES FOR HOLIDAYS

WHEREAS, the governing body of Hopkins County, the Hopkins County Fiscal Court has determined that a policy should be established for holiday pay for employees of the Hopkins County Sheriff's Department because the Hopkins County Sheriff's Department may be required to work on paid holidays.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County that the following policy shall be adopted concerning the payment of employees of the Hopkins County Sheriff's Department:

1. Should a Hopkins County Deputy Sheriff be required to work on a paid holiday, (that is a holiday for which all other County employees receive pay) then said Sheriff's Deputy shall be paid one and one-half (1-1/2) times his normal rate of pay for that day.

2. If an employee of the Hopkins County Sheriff's Department does not work on paid holidays, that employee shall receive only their regular pay rate

3. This policy shall apply to all holidays beginning the 1st day of July, 1997.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
