

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-10

**IN RE THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING FALCON CREEK WAY AND EAGLE SUMMITT
OF OTTER RIDGE SUBDIVISION INTO THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM.**

WHEREAS, the Hopkins County Fiscal Court on its own Petition has expressed the desire to bring into the County Road System a public road named Falcon Creek Way and Eagle Summitt of Otter Ridge Subdivision.

WHEREAS, notice was published according to KRS 178.050 and notices were placed at three public places in the vicinity of said road.

WHEREAS, two viewers were appointed by the Fiscal Court together with the County Road Supervisor, who viewed the proposed road establishment and reported in writing to a public hearing held on August 21, 2007.

WHEREAS, their report stated that the advantages which will result to the individual and public are: "Provide a through road from Otter Lake to J.D. Buchanan."

WHEREAS, the Hopkins County Fiscal Court finds that establishment of the subject road is in the public interest in the following respects: (1) Benefit to the public for future construction.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County that the above-described portion of the public road named shall be brought into the Hopkins County Road System.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication.

First reading of this Ordinance was held on September 4,
2007.

Riggs approved for its first reading on call, the vote stood:




Whereupon, Hopkins County Judge/Executive Donald E. Carroll
