ORDINANCE NO. 1995(4)

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE ORDINANCE RELATING TO HOPKINS COUNTY SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the governing body of Hopkins County, the Hopkins County Fiscal Court has determined that in the absence of a County Engineer, the Hopkins County Subdivision Regulations should be amended to provide for the implementation of the subdivision regulations and review of plats by an engineer to be hired by the County, and that a means of paying for said engineering services should be provided for.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County that the Ordinance relating to the Hopkins County Subdivision Regulations shall be amended as follows:

Article II, numerical paragraph 9 shall be amended to read: 9. <u>Engineer</u>: An engineer hired by Hopkins County.

Article VII, the second paragraph contained therein, shall be amended to provide that all engineering costs incurred by the County in reviewing and approving the final plat, must be paid by the Applicant, prior to approval of the plat by the Chairman of the Planning Commission.

Any reference to the County Engineer in the Hopkins County Subdivision Regulations shall be defined or amended to an engineer hired by Hopkins County.

The Hopkins County Subdivision Regulations are amended and altered in no other respect.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
