ORDINANCE NO. 1995(5)

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE HOPKINS COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AS THE SAME PERTAINS TO SMALL PURCHASE PROCEDURES AND PURCHASE ORDERS

WHEREAS, the governing body of Hopkins County, the Hopkins County Fiscal Court, has received a recommendation from the County Judge/Executive to amend the Administrative Code of Hopkins County as the same pertains to Section 424 Small Purchase Procedures (Purchase Orders), and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court has determined that the recommendation of the County/Judge Executive concerning Purchase Orders be adopted.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County that the Administrative Code of Hopkins County be amended as follows:

424.7 No purchase shall be made without an approved Purchase Order, and no purchases shall be made in excess of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) without prior Fiscal Court approval, except purchases for the Hopkins County Road Department, and Sanitation Department in case of emergency. In case of emergency, no purchase shall be made by the Hopkins County Road Department or Sanitation Department without an approved Purchase Order, and no purchase shall be made by the Hopkins County Road Department or Sanitation Department, even in case of emergency, in excess of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), without prior Fiscal Court approval.

The Administrative Code and the Small Purchase Procedures is amended or altered in no other respect.

This ordinance shall become effective upon publication.
