

ORDINANCE NO. 1995(9)

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY, ACCEPTING THE COURSES - THE BACK SIDE AREA (COUNTY CLUB ADDITION) ROAD INTO THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the governing body of Hopkins County, the Hopkins County Fiscal Court, has determined that the road located in the courses - the back side area (Country Club Addition) in Hopkins County, has been brought to the standards required by the County for its road systems and should be accepted into the County Road System for maintenance.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County as follows:

1. The road located in the back side area - (County Club Addition) meets all of the standards required for acceptance into the County Road System.
2. That the road located in and known as the back side area (Country Club Addition) shall be and is accepted into the County Road System and further maintenance for said road shall be assumed by Hopkins County.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.


UPON MOTION by Magistrate Pharris, seconded by Magistrate Stanley, first

reading was held and approved on the 3rd day of August, 1995.




